source of all bright hope in darkness and struggle; as Mary risked losing everything to carry you,

so we count all loss next to your reconciling presence,.

Move us to pray more faithfully for your peace

we need you with us to end this long night.

The first, second, third & fourth Advent candles are lit Will you join the hope alight in a young girl's eyes
